Homemade Food:

Our definition of this much abused claim is 'Food made and cooked on the premises from basic ingredients, not using packet mixes or cook in sauces'.

Because of this we can advise if the ingredients will suit particular diets or allergies.



Special diets:



In fact, we cater for vegetarian, coeliac (the proprietor can't eat gluten), lactose intolerance, low sodium and diabetic diets. We do not add salt to our recipes, preferring instead to use herbs and spices for flavouring.



We also use sugar, butter, chocolate, honey, fresh cream etc - All the 'good' things in life for that 'occasional' indulgence!

Group Bookings:

Dusty Miller's is an ideal venue for groups to meet for morning coffee, lunch, afternoon teas or suppers.

We specialise in private party bookings for the Mill, or for both the Mill and Dusty's, inside or outside of our normal trading hours.

A group menu is available and also seasonal menus such as Christmas and other special events.

History:

Dusty Miller's was previously used as a 'Shippon' (cow shed) until the late 60's when farming ceased at The Mill. The building was constructed later than The Mill, evidence of which can be seen over the waterwheel window; this has a sandstone lintel on the inside of the present building which indicates it was the outside wall of the wheelhouse building.

Dusty's was originally two rooms, and converted into one in the early 1940's when it was upgraded to comply with new farming regulations. We have left some of the original 'Boskins' which divided the room into 'Bouses' where the cows were tethered for milking. There are numerous agricultural and craft artefacts around the walls, all of which are original to The Mill and local area.

The animals:

The collection of 'stuffed' local wildlife are victims of road accidents and were not killed for display. We felt that having died in such sad circumstances it is a tribute to allow the public see examples of their species.

The collection includes a badger, adult and juvenile foxes, a polecat, a mink, a stoat, a tawny owl, a barn owl and several birds.
