

Lile Piglet - Access Statement

This access statement does not contain personal opinions as to our suitability for those with access needs, but aims to accurately describe the facilities and services that we offer visitors.

Our property is a single story Cumbrian stone building which was originally used as a farrowing house and is situated approximately 4 miles from the towns of Ulverston and Barrow-in-Furness. The cottage has a double bedroom, en-suite bathroom, lounge/dining area and kitchen, and is located in a private garden to the rear of the mill house.

The property is listed and due to the narrow doorways and access path it is not suitable for wheelchair users.

Transport

There are no bus service through the village

The nearest train stations are Ulverston, Barrow and Dalton all approx. 4 miles away.

Taxis are available from A1 Cars (01229 838383).

There is limited mobile service on the site (best being Vodafone and Orange)

Arriving by car:

Directions from M6

Leave at J36.

Take the A590 towards Kendal, then follow signs to Ulverston and Barrow. Continue to Ulverston (approx 21 miles) At Ulverston, turn left at the 3rd set of traffic lights, signed to the train station.

Follow the road out of town, past the Esso garage on the left, over two cattle grids (Birkrigg Common) until you reach the village of Scales (4 miles).

Turn right at the T junction and follow the road through the village for 500 mtrs.

Take the first left into a small country lane (watch for a small brown and white waterwheel sign on the right). You will pass the ruins of Gleaston Castle (1/2 mile on your right), and then arrive at Gleaston Water Mill (another 1/4 mile).

Satnav note: Our postcode takes you to Gleaston Castle farm, 1/4 mile to the north, so keep going south to the mill.

Key Collection, Welcome and Car Parking Facilities

On arrival please go to either Pig's Whisper Country Store or The Mill house if the shop is closed.

There is a private parking area about 20 metres from the cottage, but the access path crosses a small pedestrian bridge over the beck which has two steps at either end. Visitors with mobility problems can use a small parking bay at the front of the mill house which gives access to the cottage along a level hard path, but there are two small steps.
